- ☐ **Closing Dates 2020 31 March, 30 June, 31 August and 31 October 2020.** Late or incomplete applications will NOT be accepted. Late applications that are complete will be considered in the next round and incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant to complete.
- ☐ **Grant amounts** All tertiary grant payments are reduced by \$100 for full time or \$50 for part time after year 1 and every year thereafter.
- ☐ **Grants** You may only apply for ONE grant in each calendar year regardless of whether you are taking up multiple avenues of tertiary study.
- ☐ **Payments** Applications are assessed in the month following the closing date. For approved applications it can take up to 2 months before payment is made.
- ☐ **Withdraws** If you withdraw from your course or papers prior to or after receiving the funding, you must notify Te Āti Hau Trust. If this does not occur, you may not be eligible for future grants.
- ☐ **Notification** You will be notified of the outcome as soon as practicable after the closing date.

IMPORTANT Year 11 applicants – if you received this grant in year 10, all you need to do is send confirmation of your year 11 enrolment. You do not have to complete the application again.	This is for 1-3 years study. Full time is considered 20 hours + study per week & may vary from 9-12 months. Part time is less than 20 hours per week & less than 12 months.	Due to length of study in this field, medical students in their 4 th year are able to apply. This grant also applies to nursing students.	This is for any student who is in a postgraduate programme in any field. This includes, post graduate diploma, Masters & Doctorate.	This is for applicants studying overseas. The applicant cannot be a resident of the country they are studying in. The reason for the applicant's overseas experience must be educational.

High Performance Payment

Students that maintain an "A" average in their tertiary studies may receive an additional high achievers performance grant at the discretion of the Trust. Students will need to provide academic proof to receive this.

Previous Grants

- If you have received previous grants from the Trust indicate "Yes". Failure to answer correctly could make you ineligible to receive a grant.
- All tertiary grant payments are reduced by \$100 for full time students or \$50 for part time students after year 1 and every year thereafter. For example: if Emma studies full time for 3 years her grant payments will look like this:

Eligibility

- This section will determine if the applicant is eligible to receive a grant.
- The applicant will need to get the person from whom they descend who is an Āti hau-Whanganui Incorporation shareholder to verify their relationship.
- If you are a beneficiary of a Trust or Estate that holds shares in Āti hau-Whanganui Incorporation you will need to get one of the Trustees or Administrators to verify your status and eligibility.

Education Details

The applicant must provide confirmation of enrolment, fee payment and academic transcript. Please note that all **transcript** copies must be verified copies. This means they must be sighted against an original document by a JP, lawyer, member of faculty or Āti hau-Whanganui Incorporation staff member and stamped and signed.

Important Information
